

SILVER BROOK TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
Tuesday, November 16, 2021, 6:00 PM

Attendance: Duane Laveau, Brian Johnson, Randy Wolf, Deborah Nyberg, and Alieca Johnson. No guests were present.

Motion by Johnson; seconded by Wolf to approve the clerk's minutes from the Continuation of Annual/Regular Meeting held 09/21/21. Motion carried.

Motion by Laveau; seconded by Johnson to approve the treasurer's report (Bank statement balance 10/31/21: \$269,178.05). Motion carried

Motion by Laveau; seconded by Wolf to pay the township bills as submitted (check #s 7386-7403 - #7395-Void). Motion carried.

Duane Laveau met with Enbridge and they have hired Kiminski paving to overlay all damaged road surfaces next spring. Road areas needing repair have been marked.

Sinnott Blacktop completed mastic patching and crack sealing on Cemetery Road. Some areas repaired were very good and some need to be redone. An email was received from Kevin Smalley at Sinnott stating that they will return next spring to repair areas not up to standard.

The Wrenshall Fire Department submitted a letter asking for the township's financial support for the purchase of 14 SCBAs. The Department has applied the last several years for FEMA grants to help with the purchase, but have not been successful. Silver Brook's share is expected to be \$27,200. Motion by Wolf; seconded by Johnson to support the Wrenshall Fire Department in their purchase of SCBAs up to \$30,000. Motion carried.

Deb Nyberg provided an overview of the information received at the recent CCATO meeting. County Auditor Kevin DeVriendt should be contacted if the township wants to return to in-person voting in 2022. A quick overview of information on the new Carlton County Jail was also received.

Motion by Laveau; seconded by Wolf to adjourn the meeting at 6:45 PM. Motion carried.
